The Sibley Town Council met in regular session on Monday, January 12, 2026, at 6pm at Sibley Town Hall.

Members present were Mayor Robert Smart; Aldermen: Wayne Bolton, Richard Davis, John Langford and Keith Merritt. Pam Chanler was absent.

Mayor Smart opened the meeting in prayer; then led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Richard Davis motioned to adopt the minutes to the December 8, 2025, Regular Meeting as read, Wayne Bolton seconded. Motion carried.

No New Items were added to the agenda and there were no Public Comments.

Travis Morehart, CPA, with Cook & Morehart was present to present the 2024 – 2025 Town of Sibley Audit Report. No action was necessary.

Proposed Ordinance No. 141-F titled AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE DECLARATION OF SURPLUS PROPERTY, A 2015 FORD TAURUS POLICE UNIT BEARING VIN # ENDING IN 1440, NOT NEEDED OR USEABLE FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES, PROVIDING FOR THE SEVERABILITY OF THE DIFFERENT SECTIONS THEREOF, AND PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ALL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES was introduced. Richard Davis motioned, seconded by John Langford to set a public hearing and consideration date for February 9, 2026, during the February Regular Meeting at 6pm at the Sibley Town Hall. Motion carried.

The Board acknowledged receipt of the December 2025 Financial Report.

The mayor gave a report on wrapping up several projects and expressed necessity to have a workshop with the council about funds for ACT 461 of 2025.
