The Sibley Town Council met in regular session on Tuesday, April 12, 2016 at 6pm in the Sibley Town Hall Meeting Room.

Members present were Mayor Jimmy Williams; Aldermen Larry Merritt, Alan Myers and John Langford. Richard Davis and Doyle Chanler were absent.

Mayor Williams opened the meeting in prayer; then led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Alan Myers motioned to adopt the March 8, 2016 Regular Meeting minutes as read, John Langford seconded. Motion carried.

Amendment No. 1 of Ordinance No. 10 titled AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF SIBLEY, WEBSTER PARISH, LOUISIANA, TO PROVIDE FOR THE AUTHORITY TO SELL WATER TO THE SALT WORKS WATER SYSTEM, INC. AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF SAID VILLAGE TO EXECUTE ANY AND ALL CONTRACTS REQUIRED was added to the agenda under New Items with a motion by Larry Merritt and seconded by Alan Myers. Motion carried.

Amendment No. 1 of Ordinance No. 10 was introduced by title. A public hearing will be on May 10, 2016 at 6pm during the May Regular Meeting at the Sibley Town Hall meeting room.

Alan Myers motioned to approve Resolution No. 2016-07 opposing the closing of the Lake Bistineau State Park due to budget cuts. John Langford seconded. Motion carried.

Larry Merritt gave the monthly activity report for the Sibley Volunteer Fire Department.

Officer Mike Jones gave the monthly activity report for the Sibley Police Department.

Under Oral Communication, the budget workshop and the tax exempt status were discussed.
