The Sibley Town Council met in regular session on Monday, April 8, 2019 at 6pm in the Sibley Town Hall Meeting Room.

Members present were Mayor Jimmy Williams, Aldermen Helen Chanler, John Langford, Larry Merritt, Alan Myers, and Robert Smart.

Mayor Jimmy Williams opened the meeting in prayer; then led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Helen Chanler motioned to adopt the minutes to the March 11, 2019 Regular Meeting as read, John Langford seconded. Motion carried.

No New Items were added to the agenda.

Larry Merritt motioned to adopt Resolutions No. 2019-04, 2019-05, 2019-06, 2019-07 which addresses the reporting of Municipal Water Pollution Prevention for 2015 – 2018. Robert Smart seconded. Motion carried.

Robert Smart motioned to adopt Resolution No. 2019-08 requesting assistance from the Webster Parish Police Jury for street repairs on Cones, Critchton, Jones. Natchitoches, SE 4th, Sherwood and Weatherton Streets. Helen Chanler seconded. Motion carried.

Robert Smart motioned to adopt Resolution No. 2019-09 requesting assistance from the Webster Parish Police Jury for Drainage Issues on Cone St. and around the Waste Water Treatment Facilities. Helen Chanler seconded, motion carried.

John Langford motioned to adopt Resolution No. 2019-10 proclaiming the month of April, 2019 as, National Safe Digging Month and encourage excavators and homeowners throughout the country to always call 811 before digging. Larry Merritt seconded. Motion carried.

Robert Smart motioned to adopt Resolution No. 2019-11 opposing all proposed legislation that transfers the administration and collection of local sales & use taxes to the Louisiana Department of Revenue. Helen Chanler seconded. Motion carried.

Mr. Charlie Hunter was on the agenda to speak about finding a solution concerning the dog population and safety. There was discussion and a possible solution that an employee of the town would be trained on the retrieving and delivering the dogs on a trial basis.

Mrs. Sandra Weatherton, Ms. Carolyn Jackson and Ms. Debra Jackson were present and on the

agenda to discuss drainage issues in the Weatherton St. area. After some discussion, there will be more checking with the Webster Parish Police Jury after the current Town of Sibley resolution No. 2019-09 is adopted and sent to the Webster Parish Police Jury.

Larry Merritt gave the monthly activities report on the Sibley Volunteer Fire Department including the Annual Bass Tournament.


Sibley Police Chief Jeremy Robinson gave the March 2019 Report on Police Department activities, including camera information.


The board acknowledged that they received the March 2019 Financial Statements.
