The Sibley Town Council met in regular session on Monday, August 10, 2020, at 6:00 PM in the Sibley Town Hall Meeting Room.

Members present were Mayor Jimmy Williams, Aldermen Larry Merritt, Alan Myers, Helen Chanler, John Langford, and Robert Smart.

Mayor Williams opened the meeting with prayer and he led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Robert Smart motioned to adopt the minutes of the July 13, 2020, regular meeting as read; Alan Myers seconded. Motion carried.

There were no new items added to the agenda.

Proposed ordinance GRANTING CLAIBORNE ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE INC., ITS SUCCESSORS, SUBSIDIARIES AND ASSIGNED, THE RIGHT TO ERECT, MAINTAIN, EXTEND AND OPERATE A SYSTEM OF WORKS, POLES, WIRES, UNDERGROUND CONDUITS, CABLES AND ALL NECESSARY APPARATUS AND APPURTENANCES UNDER, ACROSS, ALONG AND OVER CERTAIN STREETS, ALLEYS AND OTHER PUBLIC AREAS IN THE TOWN OF SIBLEY, STATE OF LOUISIANA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF GENERATING ELECTRICITY AND/OR FOR THE SALE AND DISTRIBUTION OF SAME AND/OR FOR OTHER SERVICES TO THE SAID TOWN AND TO THE PUBLIC UNTIL _____, 2045, WITHIN ONLY THE LIMITS AND AREAS HEREINAFTER SET FORTH was introduced. Larry Merritt motioned to set a public hearing for September 8, 2020, during the September Regular Meeting; Alan Myers seconded. Motion carried.

Larry Merritt gave the July activity report for the Sibley Volunteer Fire Department.

Jeremy Gros gave the July activity report for the Sibley Police Department.

The board acknowledged the July financial reports.

Mayor Williams complimented John Langford for his service to the Town of Sibley during his tenure as alderman. Mayor Williams reported on the status of the splash pad that is being constructed by CW&W Contractors. Mayor Williams also told those in attendance that he is looking for equipment to resolve a water problem in a particular service line.

He stated that there has been no decision made yet about National Night Out.

Alan Myers motioned to adjourn; Helen Chanler seconded. Motion carried. The meeting was adjourned.
