The Sibley Town Council met in regular session on Tuesday, February 14, 2017 at 6pm in the Sibley Town Hall Meeting Room.

Members present were Mayor Jimmy Williams; Aldermen Doyle Chanler, John Langford, Larry Merritt, Alan Myers and Robert Smart.

Mayor Williams opened the meeting in prayer; then led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Larry Merritt motioned to adopt the minutes to the January 10, 2017 Regular Meeting minutes as read, Doyle Chanler seconded. Motion carried.

Travis Morehart, CPA of Cook and Morehart, presented the Board of Aldermen the 2015 – 2016 Audit with no findings.

Proposed Ordinance No. 141-E titled AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE DECLARATION OF A 1986 MACK FIRE TRUCK AS SURPLUS PROPERTY, NOT NEEDED OR USEABLE FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES, PROVIDING FOR THE SEVERABILITY OF THE DIFFERENT SECTIONS HEREOF, AND PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ALL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES was introduced by title. A public hearing was set for Tuesday, March 14, 2017 during the March Regular Meeting at 6pm in the Council Meeting Room at Sibley Town Hall, 345 N. Main St., Sibley, LA.

John Langford motioned to adopt Resolution No. 2017-01 requesting assistance from the Webster Parish Police Jury with culvert installations through the year 2017. Alan Myers seconded. Motion carried.

Robert Smart motioned to adopt Resolution No. 2017-02 requesting assistance from the Webster Parish Police Jury on April 8, 2017 for Sibley Annual Clean Up Day. Alan Myers seconded, motion carried.

Larry Merritt motioned to adopt Resolution No. 2017-03 authorizing a change on the LGAP funds from potable water system reparations to roofing repairs as recommended by the EMC insurance. Alan Myers seconded, motion carried.



Larry Merritt gave a monthly activity report for the Sibley Volunteer Fire Department. He also announced the arrival of the 2017 Kentworth Fire Truck.


Alan Myers motioned to adjourn, Doyle Chanler seconded. Motion carried.
