The Sibley Town Council met in regular session on Monday, March 11, 2019 at 6pm in the Sibley Town Hall Meeting Room.

Members present were Mayor Pro Tem Larry Merritt, Aldermen Helen Chanler, John Langford, Alan Myers and Robert Smart. Mayor Williams was in Washington DC.

Mayor Pro Tem Larry Merritt opened the meeting in prayer; then led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Robert Smart motioned to adopt the minutes to the February 11, 2019 Regular Meeting as read, Helen Chanler seconded. Motion carried.

Upon a unanimous vote, motioned by John Langford, seconded by Alan Myers, Robert Smart added the Police Department to the agenda under New Items.

Judge Jeff Thompson was present to share his candidacy for the Court of Appeal.

John Langford motioned to adopt Resolution No. 2019-03 requesting assistance from the Webster Parish Police Jury with ditching and drainage on NE 2<sup>nd</sup>, South 5<sup>th</sup>, Weatherton and Natchitoches streets. Robert Smart seconded. Motion carried.

Ms. Sandra Weatherton was on the agenda to request drainage relief on Weatherton. No action was taken due to the adoption of Resolution 2019-03 asking assistance for Weatherton St. area.

Upon Chief Robinson's absence, Robert Smart relayed his recommendations. Upon those recommendations, Helen Chanler motioned to accept Officer Cody James resignation. John Langford seconded. Motion carried.

Also upon the Chief's recommendation, Robert Smart motioned to hire Ronald Dean Turner to begin work on Monday, March 18, 2019. Alan Myers seconded. Motion carried.


Larry Merritt gave the monthly activities report on the Sibley Volunteer Fire Department including the upcoming Annual Bass Tournament on March 30, 2019.
