The Sibley Town Council met in regular session on Tuesday, March 8, 2016 at 6pm in the Sibley Town Hall Meeting Room.

Members present were Mayor Jimmy Williams; Aldermen Doyle Chanler, Larry Merritt and Alan Myers. Richard Davis and John Langford were absent.

Mayor Williams opened the meeting in prayer; then led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Larry Merritt motioned to adopt the February 9, 2016 Regular Meeting minutes as read, Doyle Chanler seconded. Motion carried.

No New Items were added to the agenda.

Alan Myers motioned to adopt Resolution No. 2016-05 asking for assistance from the Webster Parish Police Jury with the Town of Sibley Annual Clean Up Day on April 9, 2016. Larry Merritt seconded. Motion carried.

Doyle Chanler motioned to adopt Resolution No. 2016-06 asking for assistance from the Webster Parish Police Jury with the reparations on SE 3rd St. Alan Myers seconded. Motion carried.

Fire District #2 presented the Mayor and Aldermen a check of \$128,000.00 to Mayor Williams and the Board of Aldermen. These funds are from the 2015 property tax millage and will be used by the Sibley Fire Department for fire protection.

Larry Merritt gave a monthly activity report on the Sibley Volunteer Fire Department, as well as, reminded everyone of the SVFD Bass Tournament which will be held on Saturday, March 26, 2016.

Chief Jeremy Robinson gave a monthly activity report on the Sibley Police Department.

Mayor Williams discussed the financial situation with the State of Louisiana.

Alan Myers motioned to adjourn, Larry Merritt seconded. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned.
