Proposed 2016 Amendment to Ordinance No. 114A titled AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION AND BENEFITS TO MUNICIPAL ELECTED OFFICIALS AND MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES FOR THE TOWN OF SIBLEY, LOUISIANA, AND PROVIDING IN CONNECTION THEREWITH was introduced and a public hearing was set for Tuesday, June 14, 2016 during the June 2016 Regular Meeting at the Sibley Town Hall Meeting Room.

Chief Jeremy Robinson gave the monthly activity report for the Sibley Police Department.

Mayor Jimmy Williams updated everyone during the oral communication, about the FEMA application for the Town of Sibley, National Night Out and the testing at Aeropres on Thursday at 2pm.

Alan Myers motioned to adjourn, Doyle Chanler seconded. Motion carried.
