The Sibley Town Council met in regular session on Tuesday, May 8, 2018 at 6pm in the Sibley Town Hall Meeting Room.

Members present were Mayor Jimmy Williams, Aldermen Helen Chanler, John Langford, Larry Merritt, Alan Myers and Robert Smart.

The Mayor opened the meeting in prayer; then, asked Carl Thompson with the Webster Parish Tax Assessor's office to lead the Pledge of Allegiance.

Robert Smart motioned to adopt the minutes to the April 10, 2018 Regular Meeting as read, Larry Merritt seconded. Motion carried.

John Langford motioned to add a proposed Resolution No. 2018-10 to the agenda under New Items. Helen Chanler seconded. Motion was unanimous.

Robert Smart introduced proposed Ordinance No. 126-N-1 titled AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE BUDGET FOR THE TOWN OF SIBLEY, LOUISIANA, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2018.

Larry Merritt introduced proposed Ordinance No. 126-0 titled AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE BUDGET FOR THE TOWN OF SIBLEY, LOUISIANA FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2019.

Helen Chanler introduced proposed Ordinance No. 147-A titled AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION FOR MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES FOR THE TOWN OF SIBLEY, LOUISIANA AND PROVIDING IN CONNECTION THEREWITH.

A public hearing was set for each of the proposed ordinances for June 12, 2018, during the June Regular Meeting at 6pm at the Sibley Town Hall.

John Langford motioned to adopt Resolution No. 2018-08 to declare the 1989 Backhoe as surplus property. Alan Myers seconded. Motion carried. Advertise for sealed bids to be opened on June 1, 2018. The minimum bid is set for \$1000.

Larry Merritt motioned to adopt Resolution No. 2018-09 to authorize the mayor to negotiate the purchase of a backhoe. Robert Smart seconded. Motion carried.

Helen Chanler motioned to adopt Resolution No. 2018-10 to authorize the mayor to move forward to have the "new" backhoe on a purchase plan with Government Capital Corporation. Robert Smart seconded. Motion Carried.


Larry Merritt gave the monthly activity report for the Sibley Volunteer Fire Dept.

The Board and Mayor acknowledge the April 2018 Financial Statements.


