

ORDINANCE NO. 119

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR STOP SIGNS TO BE INSTALLED AT TWO LOCATIONS WITHIN THE TOWN LIMITS FOR THE TOWN OF SIBLEY AND TO PROVIDE FOR FINES AND PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATIONS THEREOF AND TO PROVIDE IN CONNECTION THEREWITH

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Sibley, Louisiana, in special session duly convened on the 15th day of July, 2002, as follows, to-wit:

SECTION I.

All vehicular traffic operating within the town limits of the Town of Sibley shall be obligated to stop at a three-way stop at the intersection of Weatheron and Jones Streets in the town limits for the Town of Sibley and the Town of Sibley is authorized to install a three-way stop sign at that location.

SECTION II.

All vehicular traffic operating within the town limits of the Town of Sibley shall be obligated to stop at a two-way stop at the intersection of Perritt and McDade Streets in the town limits for the Town of Sibley and the Town of Sibley is authorized to install a two-way stop sign at that location.

SECTION III.

Any person failing to make a complete stop at any of the stop signs erected in connection herewith shall be deemed to have violated Ordinance 115 or any amendments thereto and shall be subject to the penalties, fines and seizing and retention of driver's licenses as provided by Ordinance No. 115 and Ordinance No. 115-A.

SECTION IV.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION V.


