AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING TRAFFIC  
FROM HEAVY VEHICLES ON CERTAIN TOWN ROADS  
AND PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY IN VIOLATION THEREOF

DEPUTY CLERK

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Alderman of the Town of Sibley, Louisiana, in regular session duly convened on Dec. 12<sup>th</sup>, 1996 as follows:

SECTION I.

That Ordinance Number 107 of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Sibley, Louisiana, is herein acted to read as follows:

"1. It shall be illegal for any person, firm, partnership, company or business association to drive or permit to be driven upon Northeast Fifth Street and Weatherton Street in the Town Limits for the Town of Sibley, Webster Parish, Louisiana, any trucks or other vehicles weighing a total weight (including both gross weight of the vehicle and the gross weight of any load thereon) in excess of 10 tons (20,000 pounds).

2. Any person, firm, corporation, partnership or business association who or which shall violate this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and after conviction thereof, shall be punished by fine of not less than \$50.00, no more than \$200.00 or imprisonment for up to but not in excess of thirty (30) days or both, for each violation. Each day in which the violation shall continue shall be deemed a separate offense.

3. In addition to other remedies provided, the Town of Sibley shall be entitled to seek a temporary restraining order or writ of injunction prohibiting and enjoining any person, firm, partnership, corporation or other business association from continuing to violate this ordinance or from the utilization of heavy vehicles in excess of the weight limit provided herein, and in addition, the Town of Sibley shall be permitted to pursue a civil claim for damages to the public streets for any damages caused or occasioned as a result of the usage by heavy traffic referred to hereinabove."

II. All other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed and amended.

III. If any provisions or items of this ordinance or the application thereof is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions, items or applications of this ordinance which can be given affect without the invalid provisions, items or applications, and to this end the provision of this ordinance are hereby declared severable.

All ordinances or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed and amended.
