

ORDINANCE NO. 3A

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING BY REFERENCE ALL OF THE PROVISIONS OF THE LOUISIANA HIGHWAY REGULATORY ACT AND THE REGULATIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT AND DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY OF THE STATE OF LOUISIANA WITH RESPECT TO ANY HIGHWAY WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF SIBLEY, LOUISIANA, AND PRESCRIBING SPEED LIMITATIONS FOR MOTOR VEHICLES OPERATING ON THE STREETS AND HIGHWAYS OF THE VILLAGE OF SIBLEY, LOUISIANA

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Village of Sibley, Louisiana, in regular session convened on March 8, 1984, as follows:

SECTION 1:

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Aldermen for the Village of Sibley, that pursuant to the authority conferred in LA R.S. 32:41 (C) the provisions of the Louisiana Highway Regulatory Act, LA R.S. 32:1-32:399, and all regulations of the Department and Director of Public Safety for the State of Louisiana, adopted pursuant thereto with respect to any state highway within the corporate limits of the Village of Sibley, Louisiana, are hereby adopted by the Village of Sibley. The provisions of that act and the regulations adopted pursuant thereto shall be ordinances of the Village of Sibley, Louisiana.

SECTION 2:

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that any person who violates this ordinance and/or the provisions of the Louisiana Highway Regulatory Act and the regulations of the Department and Director of Public Safety adopted thereto shall be punished by a fine of not more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) or by imprisonment for not more than thirty (30) days, or both.

SECTION 3:

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that if any part of this ordinance or any part of the Louisiana Highway Regulatory Act adopted herein by reference and any regulations of the Department and Director of Public Safety of the State of Louisiana, adopted pursuant thereto be declared unconstitutional or invalid the other parts thereof shall not be thereby effected.

SECTION 4:

No person shall operate or drive any passenger vehicle upon the streets or highways within the Village of Sibley, Louisiana, in excess of the following speeds:

- A. 45 miles per hour on State Route 7 from the North city limits, a point 0.11 miles North of North 3rd Street, and extending in a southerly direction to a point 0.04 miles South of North 3rd Street, a total distance of 0.15 miles;

- B. 25 miles per hour on State Route 7 from a point 0.04 miles South of North 3rd Street and extending in a southerly direction to a point 0.02 miles South of South 1st Street, a total distance of 0.37 miles;
- C. 35 miles per hour on State Route 7 from a point 0.02 miles South of South 1st Street and extending in a southerly direction to a point 0.08 miles South of South 1st Street, a total distance of 0.37 miles;
- D. 45 miles per hour on State Route 7 from a point 0.08 miles South of South 3rd Street and extending in a southerly direction to the South city limits in a point 0.54 miles South of South 3rd Street, a total distance of 0.46 miles;
- E. 35 miles per hour on State Route 164 from the West city limits a point 0.15 miles West of State Route 7 and extending in an easterly direction to State Route 7, a total distance of 0.15 miles;
- F. 25 miles per hour on all other streets and highways within the Village of Sibley, Louisiana.

SECTION 5:

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
