

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE TRAFFIC AND MOTOR VEHICLE OPERATIONS REGULATIONS IN AND FOR THE MUNICIPALITY OF SIBLEY, LOUISIANA.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Council of the Town of Sibley, Louisiana, in regular session convened on the First day of November, 1971, as follows:

Section 1: The principal laws relating to motor vehicles and their operation on the streets and highways of Louisiana, as amended through the 1970 regular session of the Legislature, which are contained in the publication by the Louisiana Legislative Council entitled Louisiana Motor Vehicle Laws are hereby adopted as municipal law in and for the Town of Sibley.

Section 2: It shall be unlawful for any Person to operate a motor vehicle in the Town of Sibley except by these regulations.

Section 3: In the event any motor vehicle operation within the corporate limits of the Town of Sibley fails to comply with the Provisions of Section 1, the Chief of Police is hereby authorized, empowered, and directed to enforce the aforementioned provisions.

Section 4: That all ordinances or part of ordinances or resolutions inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 5: Fines shall be limited by the attached fine limitations.
