

ORDINANCE NO. 88

AN ORDINANCE REDESIGNATING THE NAMES OF STREETS AND AVENUES WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF SIBLEY

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Village of Sibley, Louisiana, in regular session convened on December 13, 1984, as follows:

SECTION I.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Aldermen for the Village of Sibley that Ordinance No. 88 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

- "1. All thoroughfares running North and South within the corporate limits of the Village of Sibley shall be hereinafter designated as streets, and all thoroughfares running in an East West direction within the corporate limits of the Village of Sibley shall be hereafter designated as avenues.
- "2. The street currently known as West Second Street, at the entrance to Sherwood Lane, shall hereafter be designated as FRAZIER STREET.
- "3. The thoroughfare beginning at the end of 5th Avenue, at its curve, and running approximately one block North, and then proceeding South to the point of termination at the IC Railroad crossing shall hereafter be known as WEATHERTON STREET, and that portion of a thoroughfare previously known as North Claiborne will hereafter be known as WEATHERTON STREET.
- "4. The thoroughfare beginning at approximately the intersection of North 2nd Avenue and Weatherton Street, running Northwesterly along the L&A Railroad tract, and which crosses North 5th Avenue and terminates approximately one quarter mile North of 5th Avenue, will henceforth be known as JOHNSON STREET.
- "5. The thoroughfare beginning on the East side of Weatherton Street near the termination of 5th Avenue and running East and Northeast to the Village Limits shall be henceforth known as JONES AVENUE.
- "6. The thoroughfare beginning at the intersection of Weatherton Street and the Illinois Central Railroad and running in a Northeasterly direction to its point of termination, will henceforth be known as HAWK LANE.
- "7. The thoroughfare beginning at the entrance to the Prairie Grove Subdivision, on Parish Road 159, and extending in a Northerly direction, will henceforth be known as AMY STREET.
- "8. The thoroughfare located at the intersection of Amy Street and running North to a thoroughfare which runs East and West shall henceforth be known as TACOMA TRAIL.
- "9. The drive for the Southwood Apartments located just South of Sibley on Parish Road 159, located on Circle Drive, shall henceforth be known as SOUTHWOOD CIRCLE.
- "10. That portion of Highway 7 located North of the Railroad bridge crossing and/or red light shall be designated as

Main Street North, and that portion of Highway 7 running South from the railroad crossing and/or red light shall be designated Main Street South. Thoroughfares running perpendicular to North Main Street shall be designated with the name of either Northeast or Northwest added to the name, depending upon the direction of travel of the thoroughfare. Thoroughfares running perpendicular to South Main Street shall be designated either Southeast or Southwest depending on direction of travel of the thoroughfare.

"11. All records of the Village of Sibley or other records are hereby corrected to reflect the designation set forth herein."

SECTION II.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all ordinances or parts thereof in conflict therewith are hereby repealed and amended.
