Robert Smart motioned to adopt Resolution No. 2022-02, requesting assistance from the Webster Parish Police Jury for installation of culverts for the Town of Sibley citizens for the year 2022. Richard Davis seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

Richard Davis gave the December, 2021, monthly activity report for the Sibley Volunteer Fire Department.

Officer Jeremy Gros gave the December, 2021, monthly activity report for the Sibley Police Department.

Robert Smart motioned to accept the Sibley Fire Department report and the Sibley Police report.

The aldermen acknowledged that they received the December, 2021, Financial Report.

Alan Myers motioned to adjourn the meeting, Helen Chanler seconded. Motion carried. The meeting adjourned at 6:25 PM.
